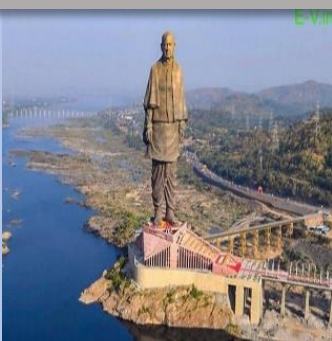

The World-famous Statue of Unity, Gujarat, India. The driving distance from Nandurbar to Statue of Unity Road is 158 km. and the train takes 6hr 20 min to reach Kevadiya.
